- Restore Longstanding Protections for Student Survivors
- Develop Robust Protections Against Retaliation
- Ensure Fair Disciplinary Procedures and School Flexibility
- Address Other Forms of Harassment
- Create implementation for funding for tribal colleges and universities for expansive Title IX supports
- Advocate to strengthen support for survivors when they report
- Create and increase protections for transgender students, treat transgender students according to their gender identity, and end gender based/anti-transgender discrimination in sports in colleges and universities
- Increase support for campus advocates and support survivors on campus
- Hearings should be afforded through the Title IX process
- Expand Title IX to colleges that do not receive federal funding
