I am Donald H. Morgan, M.D., a retired physician of internal medicine. I live in (b)(6) where my practice of internal medicine was located for more than twenty years.

I write you to urge your continuation of the new Title IX rules regarding due process rights for those accused of crimes on the nation's college and university campuses. Specifically, I am referring to the right to have a live hearing, with cross examination; to see evidence; and to have the presumption of innocence. These are basic constitutional rights which were ignored until the previous administration put them into effect last August.

I urge your to resist any effort to return the nation's institutions of higher learning to the days of Star Chambers and kangaroo courts.
