My name is Hettie Sullivan. I am a 49 year old female with (b)(6) children who attend public school in (b)(6)

I urge you to provide guidance affirming the permissibility of sex-based classification in certain narrowly drawn circumstances. Gender identity is NOT equivalent to nor a substitute for sex.

It is possible to to protect students from discrimination on the basis of transgender status or gender identity and sexual orientation while simultaneously recognizing biological sex where sex is important.

Female students are the intended beneficiaries of the Title IX.

As OCR considers changes to and new interpretations of the Title IX regulations, female people must be remembered as the designated beneficiaries of the legislation. Protecting all students requires fairness for ALL students, including FEMALE students.
